Kate Anderson

Kate Anderson transitioned her painting background into a full career in fiber and textile after a knotting workshop at Craft Alliance in St. Louis. Now with nearly 30 years experience knotting, she references art history, popular culture, and dialogue with her knotted non-functional teapots, cups and other forms. Anderson encourages a reconsideration of historic images by placing them in a new context, incorporating poetry, politics and varying languages in her diverse works. Her work revitalizes vintage American iconography, allowing one to revisit subjects and media with a contemporary lens.
